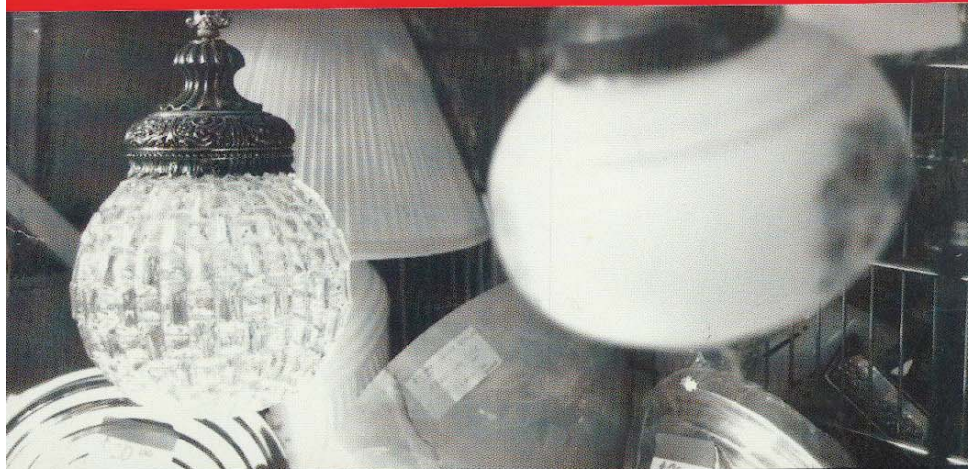

Depending on the recent hauls, owner Sam Mirshak may also have Edwardian glass light fixtures, Victorian wire garden decorations, art deco panels, and a huge assortment of hardware of all types and for all budgets—everything is at wholesale prices.
